      - Costs about \$75 to do online and \$20 in person or through the mail

- Applications must be made **in person** at an OR [DMV office](#). You will need:
- [Proof of your identity, date of birth and legal U.S. presence](#), such as your:
    - o U.S. citizenship certificate.
    - o U.S. [birth certificate](#).
    - o Foreign passport and I-94 printout.
  - [Proof of your Oregon residency](#), such as your:
    - o Utility bill.
    - o Bank statement.
    - o Insurance card.

\* You may not have proof of residency, so you could get a letter from a school staff member or case manager to verify your residence.
