**If you are literally homeless** (camping or sleeping in a car or shed), you can ask to be put on the Centralized Wait List. If you are on that list, you can qualify for housing with:

1. **Rapid Rehousing Program:** pays application fees, move in deposits, rent, and utility payments for two years. Also provides case management.
2. **Transitional Housing Program:** for girls 16-21. You live in apartments upstairs from New Roads, and this program has intensive case management by the on-site property manager

**If you are couch surfing**, or staying with people but don't have a fixed, regular address, you may be eligible for:

3. **Transitional Living Program:** each enrolled client can get up to \$1500 of financial assistance to move into a new apartment. They will work with you to prepare you to get into housing, and you will need to prove you can pay rent before they will pay a deposit.
